Must-know Details

- Parent(s) serve as **LEARNING COACHES** and support their child with academics for 3-6 hours a day (depending on grade level)
- Parent(s) must participate in an informational presentation prior to signing the Master Agreement
- New students will automatically be placed on a trial period of 8 weeks to determine potential for long-term success
- Students having academic challenges will be placed on Academic Probation
- Re-engagement and Intervention will be provided
- Students who do not meet the requirements outlined in the Master Agreement can be dismissed from LAVA
- Enrolled students opt-in for all formative assessments and academic diagnostics
- Virtual learning time is flexible, but equivalent to a comprehensive campus (6-7 hours daily)
