

Check In Check Out (CICO) Program
Parent Information

The CICO program is a school wide, check in check out prevention program for students who are starting to engage in problem behavior. The goal of the CICO program is to prevent students who are acting out from escalation and provide them with more frequent feedback on their behavior to prevent future problem behavior. Students will receive rewards when they meet their goals.

- Students will complete a "check in" with a CICO facilitator each morning upon arriving at school. The facilitator or "coach" will give the student a Daily Progress Report (DPR) and remind the student about expected behaviors and daily goals. The teacher will provide feedback on the DPR during transitions throughout the day. The teacher will then rate the student using a point system.
- The student will take the DPR to their facilitator during the day and at the end of the school day. They will total the points earned on the DPR.
- Students will take the DPR home to share with family.
- Parents are asked to sign and then return the DPR to school with the student the following day.
- Data will be collected and when the student meets their overall goal they will fade out and then graduate from the program.
