Principal's Message:

It's hard to believe that the first quarter is already over – it seems as if the school year just began and now it's already feeling like Fall! It has been an exciting and busy start to the school year, and I know that the first quarter has been rewarding and successful for our students! I hope that everyone takes advantage of the upcoming Parent Teacher Conference days to schedule a conference with their child's teacher. We are all partners in this important job of raising educated, thoughtful, and happy children, and I know that our teachers look forward to working productively with you. There will be no school on Wednesday, October 26, and Thursday, October 27 will be a minimum day with 12:50 dismissal so that teachers have an opportunity to meet with families.

Halloween:

As in previous years, students may dress up in their costumes for the Halloween parade around the Quad. Students may put on their costumes at 2:30, and the parade will be at 2:45. Parents are welcome to join us for the festivities at 2:30. Please be sure that all costumes are appropriate for elementary school – no masks or excessively scary or gory costumes, and clothing must meet our usual dress code standards. Please be mindful that many of our students have expressed fear regarding the clown nonsense that has been on the news so much lately; for that reason, no masks will be allowed, and we ask parents to be mindful of these concerns when planning for the school parade.

School safety is a primary concern for us, and we regularly practice all sorts of drills, including fire, earthquake, lock-down, and shelter in place. On October 20 at 10:20, we will participate in the Great California Shake-out, where we'll practice our Drop, Cover, and Hold procedures, then evacuate to the field. Our goal in these drills is to learn how we can improve our emergency response in order to keep everyone as safe as possible. It's a great time to review our emergency procedures and preparation as home as well – we never know when emergencies may occur! I'd like to thank all of our families who are helping us to keep the school safe by following the pick-up and drop-off procedures each day. I know that the traffic can be very frustrating, and I appreciate our families setting a good example for the students by being patient, and careful each day as they pick or drop off their children. I'd like to ask that parents not check their children out early as a way to avoid the traffic – not only does it cost your child valuable instructional minutes, but early check-outs disrupt the educational process for the entire class.
