Dear Eighth Grade Endeavour Students and Parents:

We want to bring to your attention the requirements for **End-of-the-Year Eighth Grade Activities** as stated in the EMS Handbook.

Students must meet the following standards to participate in the end of year activities, including the Promotion Dance, and the Magic Mountain Trip:

- 1. Students must have a "C" in citizenship for 4th quarter and a minimum of two other quarters.
- 2. Students must have achieved a total cumulative 3.66 GPA (Semester 1 GPA + Semester 2 GPA), excluding Homeroom and Citizenship grades.
- 3. Only eligible currently enrolled and promoting eighth grade EMS students are permitted to participate in end of year activities. NO guests are allowed.
- 4. All outstanding fees (textbooks, library books, cafeteria accounts, and PE locks) must be paid.
- 5. Any student who is suspended from regular school activities is ineligible for any extracurricular activities taking place on that day including end of year activities such as Magic Mountain Trip, Promotion Dance, and Promotion Ceremony.
- 6. Any 6th or 7th grade student or **ineligible** 8th grade student who attends Magic Mountain Fun Day is in violation of school rules and State law (because he or she is thus truant). Any promoting 8th grade student who is ineligible to attend Magic Mountain but attends anyway, will not walk at promotion.

This is not in the EMS Handbook but is for your information. If a student has had his or her bus privileges taken away or has a bus ticket at the time of the Magic Mountain Fun Day they will not be allowed to ride the bus to Magic Mountain thus they will not be able to attend.

Promotion Ceremony

Only students who have met stated criteria and are eligible to be promoted to 9th grade may participate in promotion ceremonies. Board Policy (5123) states:

A student academically eligible for 8th grade promotion may be denied participation in the promotion ceremony for any of the following reasons (4.4.1). On suspension or recommended for expulsion at the time of promotion (4.4.1.1). The decision to revoke promotion privileges remains with the principal of the school (4.4.2).

- <u>Seating is limited.</u> 8th grade students will only attend ceremonies in which they are participating. Please limit attendees to <u>immediate family only</u>. We encourage you to find sitters for small children. Due to space limitations, please do not bring strollers/baby carriers to the ceremonies.
- Students have completed their 8th grade year at the conclusion of the promotion ceremony, and are expected to leave with parents.
- 8th grade students who are on campus during a promotion ceremony other than their own will be placed in a classroom for the remainder of the school day (i.e., until 1:02 pm).

Parking/Balloons

- The parking lot in front of the school (45th street West) will be closed, except to those cars with handicapped placards, and people entering on foot.
- Due to construction starting on the south end of our campus we encourage parents to walk <u>OR</u> park in surrounding neighborhoods.
- Walking is strongly encouraged! You may enter through open gates off 45th Street West (front of school), or on 46th Street West (behind the school) near the basketball courts.
- In order to avoid obstructing views, please present balloons to students at home.
- Those who bring balloons to the ceremony will be asked to sit in the rear of the cafeteria.
