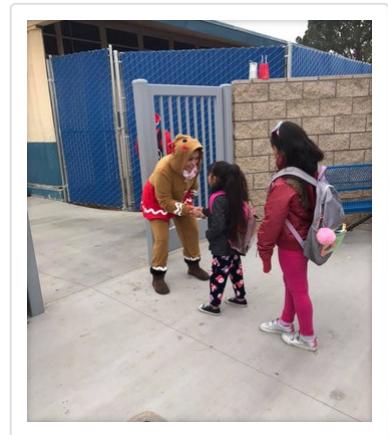
We are preparing our students for their future and are thankful for each and every one of them!



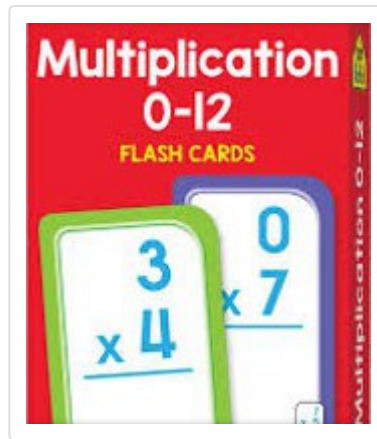

How many absences?

- Starting in kindergarten, too many absences can cause children to fall behind in school.
 - Missing 10 percent (or about 18 days) can make it harder to learn to read.
 - Students can still fall behind if they miss just a day or two days every few weeks.
 - Being late to school may lead to poor attendance.
 - Absences can affect the whole classroom if the teacher has to slow down learning to help children catch up.
- Attending school regularly helps children feel better about school—and themselves. Start building this habit in preschool so they learn right away that going to school on time, every day is important. Good attendance will help children do well in high school, college, and at work.

Helping your child at home!

Foundational tools are the foundation to reading and writing.

The dollar store has math and sight word flash cards. Students need to control addition, subtraction, multiplication and division in math.

Students need to control sight words in Language Arts.

Take 15 minutes for flash card work every night and read to your child for 20 minutes or if they know how to read set the timer! Check out the link to the comparison of minutes read between three students.
