Home School Options for Transitional Kindergarten -2nd Grade

Students in Grades TK-2 are eligible to enroll in the home school option at Lancaster Alternative and Virtual Academies. Home schooling provides a unique opportunity to engage your child in hands-on learning activities and monitor your child's progress. Home schooling allows parents to develop a deep bond with their child as their primary teacher.

Parents and Guardians will develop a partnership with a credentialed teacher who will assist you in educating your child. Meetings every two weeks will support you and your child with progress monitoring and guidance to ensure your child is learning at an appropriate rate.

Technology, manipulatives, reading materials and textbooks are all available at no cost. The Lancaster School District Program is a high quality educational choice for your child ensuring equitable access to instruction and progress monitoring so the parent/guardian is fully aware of the student's progress.
