| Number and duration of sessions | <p>Recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Administer CAT items in one or two sessions (recommended) and no more than six sessions (rare or extreme). • Session durations range from 45-60 minutes. <p>Most students will complete the CAT items in one or two sessions of 60 minutes or less or one long session of more than 60 minutes.</p> | <p>The PT is presented in two parts.</p> <p>ELA recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Administer the ELA PT in two sessions corresponding to parts 1 and 2 of the PT. • ELA session durations range from 60-120 minutes. Part 2 should be scheduled to allow students enough time to complete the full write in one test session. <p>Mathematics recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Administer the mathematics PT in one session. • The mathematics session duration ranges from 45-120 minutes. | <p>Recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The CAAs should be administered in as many testing sessions and days required to meet the needs of the student. • The TE can make the decision to pause and resume the test administration if the student is no longer engaged, is not actively participating, or is showing signs of behavioral or functional concerns related to the test. |
