- California Alternate Assessments (CAAs) for English Language Arts/Literacy (ELA) and Mathematics in grades three through eight

Student Score Reports for the Smarter Balanced and California Alternate Assessments can now be accessed electronically through the parent portal on PowerSchool - https://pschool.lancsd.org/public/. Log into your account and click on Score Reports on the left side menu bar. If you do not have access to a computer, you may to go your child's school and request assistance in obtaining your child's Score Report.

This report shows scores for ELA and mathematics. It includes an overall score for each subject and information about how well your child did in different areas. Students in grades four through eight who took the test in the previous years will also see past scores so you can see your child's progress over time.
