Dear Fulton & Alsbury Students and Parents,

Welcome to our Summer Reading Passport! Summer reading is an essential element of a good education. It has been proven that students who read four or more books over the summer are far more likely to score higher on rigorous reading-comprehension tests than their peers who read one or no books. The “summer slide” of reading comprehension skills is cumulative, meaning if your child does not read throughout the summer, his or her literacy skills could fall. That being said, we encourage summer reading and activities associated with good reading habits.

Our Summer Reading Passport encourages choice and new experiences. Please see the Fulton & Alsbury Summer Reading Passport. We encourage students to complete at least one row (up/down, across, or diagonal) or more over the summer. Students are able to take Reading Counts tests on the books they read over summer. When we return to school in August, all students participating in the Summer Reading Passport will be acknowledged.
