
The duty aides we have grown close to, bonded with, and seem to have connected with on certain levels since we treat them like friends.

Other than tryouts the team is currently focused on perfecting the Cha-Cha. They are also learning the steps to the Bachata.
















YEARBOOK AND NEWSPAPER


Spread love by giving to Toys For Tots.
