Welcome to The Leadership Academy! Your student is scheduled to begin the 2021-2022 school year at The Leadership Academy, on Tuesday, August 10th. School start and end times are as follows: Elementary grades 2-5 (8:15 am -2:55 pm), Middle School grades 6-8 (8:00 am – 2:40 pm), Hybrid Distance Learning grades 2-8 (8:30 am – 3:10 pm depending on the block student attends). Class assignments will be given out the week prior to the first day of school.

Great news for you and your students! All enrolled students of the Lancaster School District are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school with no cost to your household each day of the 2021 - 2022 school year. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit an application.

As you are purchasing school clothes, keep in mind that at The Leadership Academy, we wear uniforms! Students are required to wear navy blue polo-styled shirts with tan khaki styled pants, shorts, or skirts.
